Children

- Children of all ages in your home should be included in the census count.
- Children who split time between homes should be counted in the home they live in most throughout the year.



Roommates

- Roommates or housemates should choose one person to complete the census count.
- Every person living in the home should be counted.



College Students

- College students should complete the census where they are living on April 1.
- Parents should not count students who are living away from home while in college.



Immigrants

- Regardless of legal status, anyone living in the United States on April 1 should be counted in the census.



Extended Family and Tenants

- Any extended family or tenants living in your home on April 1 should be counted.
- People who split time between homes should be counted in the residence they live in most.

Fair representation and equitable services are based on an accurate population count.
Every person not counted in our community is a loss of more than \$1,800 annually in state and federal funding.
