

**PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF HILLSBOROUGH
CONSENTING TO APPLICATION OF THE AMEMNDMENT TO THE
DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY IN
ORANGE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA
DATED JULY 9, 2020
WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF HILLSBOROUGH**

WHEREAS, Orange County Board of Commissioners Chair Penny Rich on the 13th day of March, 2020, signed a Declaration (the “Declaration”) of State of Emergency in Orange County ordering restrictions on activity of residents of Orange County in response to the COVID-19 Public Health Crisis; and

WHEREAS, on March 26, 2020 the undersigned Mayor of he Town of Hillsborough issued a Proclamation (the ‘Proclamation”) declaring a state of emergency to exist in the Town of Hillsborough and ordered certain restrictions to be effective in Hillsborough’s corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Proclamation the undersigned also consented to the application of the Orange County Declaration inside Hillsborough’s corporate limits pursuant to authority granted by N.C. Gen. Stat. 166A-19.22(b)(2); and

WHEREAS, since March 26, 2020 the Governor of the State of North Carolina has issued Executive Orders 138, 141, 147 and 148, *inter alia*, and Orange County has amended its Declaration on or about May 22, 2020, June 10, 2020, June 26, 2020 and July 9, 2020, And there have been changes made to Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes concerning the process for municipalities to declare states of emergency; and


WHEREAS I, as Mayor of the Town of Hillsborough, desire to update and clarify the effect of the various Executive Orders and Orange County Declarations inside Hillsborough’s corporate limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jenn Weaver, Mayor of the Town of Hillsborough, do hereby proclaim the continued existence of a STATE OF EMERGENCY within the Town of Hillsborough, and, pursuant to the authority granted to me by State law and Town ordinance, hereby ORDER as follows:


1. For the reasons and based on the findings stated in the attached Amended Declaration of State of Emergency in Orange County, I consent to the application of said Amended Declaration within the Town of Hillsborough pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. 166A-19.22(b)(2), and incorporate all terms of said Amended declaration herein by reference as if it were fully reproduced here.
2. This Proclamation shall be effective immediately and remain in effect until properly rescinded or modified by subsequent Proclamation.

3. A copy of this amended Proclamation shall be provided to the Town Clerk. Reports of the substance of the prohibitions and restrictions of this Proclamation shall be sent to the mass media communications serving the Town of Hillsborough immediately, and the full text of this Proclamation shall be distributed to the mass communications media serving the Town of Hillsborough. A copy of this Proclamation shall be posted conspicuously on the Town of Hillsborough website at <https://www.hillsboroughnc.gov/community/covid-19-coronavirus/covid-19-restrictions/>, and a Notice and a signed copy of this Proclamation shall be submitted to the Department of Public Safety WebEOC.
